Ukrainian Parliament has adopted the law on raising the social standards

On 20 October 2009 Ukrainian Parliament voted for the adoption of the Law "On Implementation of the Minimum Subsistence Level and Minimum Wage".

According to the Law, monthly subsistence minimum per person will be as follows:

starting from 1 November 2009 - UAH 701;
starting from 1 January 2010 - UAH 825;
starting from 1 April 2010 - UAH 839;
starting from 1 July 2010 - UAH 843;
starting from 1 October 2010 - UAH 861;
starting from 1 December 2010 - UAH 875.

The Law also envisages that the minimum wage will be set at the following levels:

starting from 1 November 2009 - UAH 744;
starting from 1 January 2010 - UAH 869;
starting from 1 April 2010 - UAH 884;
starting from 1 July 2010 - UAH 888;
starting from 1 October 2010 - UAH 907;
starting from 1 December 2010 - UAH 922.

The Law has been sent to the President of Ukraine for signing. Please note, however, that the Prime Minister of Ukraine publicly informed that she would ask the President to veto the respective Law.
