Hilmi Panigoro is an Indonesian citizen, born in Bandung on 4 April 1955. He earned a degree in Geological Engineering from the Bandung Institute of Technology, Indonesia, in 1981, and later enrolled in the MBA Core Program at Thunderbird University, USA, in 1984.

Hilmi has dedicated more than 44 years to the oil and gas industry. Within MedcoEnergi, he has held several key leadership positions, serving as Director (1998 to 2001), President Director (2001 to 2008), and President Commissioner (2008 to 2015). He was reappointed as President Director by the Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders on 25 November 2015.

In addition to his role as President Director, Hilmi is a member of the Sustainability & Risk Management Committee and the Good Corporate Governance (GCG) Committee. He also serves as Director and Commissioner in several subsidiaries within the MedcoEnergi Group.

About MedcoEnergi

Established in 1980, PT Medco Energi Internasional Tbk (“MedcoEnergi”) is a leading Southeast Asian energy and natural resources company listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange (MEDC-IDX). MedcoEnergi has three key business segments, Oil & Gas, Power and Copper Mining.

MedcoEnergi explores for and produces oil and gas primarily in Indonesia. The Group operates gas, PV, geothermal and hydro power plants in Indonesia through Medco Power and has a non-consolidated interest in PT Amman Mineral Internasional Tbk which operates a large copper and gold mine.

Agus Susanto

PT Prima Multi Usaha Indonesia Tbk



Agus Susanto is the President Director of PT Prima Multi Usaha Indonesia (PMUI), XL Axiata's largest distributor by coverage and transaction value. PMUI was established in 2011, but the story began in 1998 when his older brother sold used phones on the streets of Cirebon. Agus joined in 2000 and transformed a single counter into a real operation, added SIM cards and top-up vouchers, oversaw in-house stock and cash controls, and opened new locations. From 2002 to 2006 the business expanded to become the largest handset distributor in Cirebon, later securing XL's exclusive distributorship which became the launchpad for broader growth.

He took the helm as President Director in 2022 and spearheaded PMUI's listing on the Indonesia Stock Exchange in July 2025, achieving a valuation of IDR 1 trillion. He sees the IPO as a stepping stone toward the Company's next chapter, with plans to expand into manufacturing and FMCG distribution while strengthening its core in telecom, logistics, and retail. He believes lasting success comes from strong systems, aligned teams, and staying close to daily operations.

PMUI has now grown into a network of 120 branches across 12 provinces. The Company employs nearly 7,000 people and serves more than 200,000 retailers. Agus attributes this success to a steadfast commitment to discipline, integrity, and valuing people over credentials. Many long-serving team members joined without formal education, proving that loyalty, character and innate ability matter most.

He also prioritizes ethics and social impact. PMUI runs programs in education, health, and the environment, and upholds zero tolerance for fraud, bullying, or discrimination. For him, entrepreneurship is about creating long-term value with purpose beyond profit.

PT Sumber Sinergi Makmur Tbk



Alamsyah is the founder of Fox Logger, Indonesia’s leading GPS tracker company by sales volume. He launched the business in 2015 with just USD 13,000 and a 12-square-meter office. Through sharp execution and practical innovation, he scaled it into a publicly-listed company with a market capitalization of USD 70 million. Today, Fox Logger delivers IoT-based vehicle tracking solutions for both individual users and logistics companies across Indonesia.

The Company’s competitive edge stems from its deep local knowledge and proprietary technology. Instead of relying on off-the-shelf solutions, Alamsyah led the creation of custom GPS tracking devices, and a fleet management platform designed for Indonesian users - monitoring routes, parking, mileage, and more. To ensure stable pricing and supply, Fox Logger built direct ties with manufacturers and used predictive procurement.

Alamsyah promotes a fast-paced, ownership-driven culture, believing smaller teams move faster and deliver better results. Employees are encouraged to think like business owners, with many department heads rising through merit-based promotions. This agile, problem-solving mindset keeps the Company competitive in a fast-changing market.

Looking forward, Alamsyah is evolving Fox Logger toward becoming a broader mobility solutions provider. The Company is expanding into predictive maintenance, AI-driven driver behavior analysis, EV fleet integration, and smart city initiatives. With a growing focus on sustainability, Fox Logger also supports clients in reducing emissions and backs digital education efforts. Alamsyah continues to lead with a clear goal: to build technology that delivers long-term value for businesses and communities.

PT Mandaya Sehat Utama



Dr. Ben Widaja, MBChB (UK), is the President Director and Co-Founder of Mandaya Hospital Group, leading the transformation of healthcare in Indonesia. After training and working in the United Kingdom, Dr. Ben returned to Indonesia to address gaps in access, care, and patient experience. Combining medical expertise with his family’s hospitality roots, he built Mandaya Royal Hospital Puri into a top national referral center. Despite early challenges, it became EBITDA-positive in five months and profitable within two years.

Mandaya Hospital Group began as a family-led healthcare venture, with Dr. Ben driving its growth. The Hospital’s staff complement rapidly expanded to nearly 1,000 staff and 170+ doctors across 70 specialties. Known for centers like the Mandaya Breast and Robotic Surgery Centers, the Group integrates advanced technology. Dr. Ben took significant personal and financial risks to build trust and secure funding.

Innovation is central to Mandaya’s success. Dedicated teams manage patient feedback and service development, creating unique experiences such as candlelit dinners for parents of newborn babies, and play coordinators for children. Clinically, Mandaya offers Indonesia’s first private liver transplant program and advanced oncology care. Dr. Ben fosters a culture of service excellence and staff development through education sponsorships and mentoring programs.

With a clear vision to elevate Indonesian healthcare to global standards, Dr. Ben leads Mandaya in delivering advanced, compassionate care while giving back through community programs like the “Geng Macan” cancer survivor support group. Under his leadership, Mandaya is setting new benchmarks for quality, innovation, and patient experience nationwide.

PT Centrepark Citra Corpora



Charles Richard Oentomo is the President Director of PT Centrepark Citra Corpora, Indonesia's top parking and mobility infrastructure company. Since founding Centrepark in 2009, Charles has grown it from two sites and 50 employees to over 700 locations in 60 cities. Now processing 350+ million transactions annually - 85% cashless, his mission has been to modernize Indonesia's parking ecosystem through technology and operational discipline.

The COVID-19 pandemic disrupted operations and forced workforce cuts. Charles used the crisis to fast-track digital adoption, launching contactless systems and tech-driven cost efficiencies. These efforts enabled a swift recovery, rehiring, and increased market share.

Under his leadership, Centrepark has become an integrated mobility provider, expanding into EV charging, digital advertising, and property services. The Company continues to grow at double-digit rates, driven by a performance-focused culture and employee-led innovation.

The Company promotes digital processes to reduce emissions, invests in employee upskilling, and prioritizes inclusivity with 30% female workforce participation. It also engages in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities such as disaster relief and education programs. Charles continues to lead with a focus on resilience, long-term value creation, and impact on driving Centrepark's mission to improve daily life through smarter, more reliable urban mobility.

Gusmantara Eka Himawan

PT Xurya Daya Indonesia



Gusmantara Ekamukti Himawan (Eka) is the Co-Founder and Managing Director of Xurya, a leading player in Indonesia's solar energy sector. By introducing a no-upfront-cost rental model, the Company accelerated solar adoption in a fossil fuel-dominated market. Xurya has installed over 200 MWp of rooftop solar for 150+ clients, contributing nearly a third of the country's total rooftop capacity.

Xurya's early years were marked by limited policy support, market skepticism, and financial risk. Eka and his co-founders invested personal savings to develop a localized financing and operations model. Despite regulatory shifts and the pandemic, the Company continued to grow and is now expanding into off-grid and utility-scale projects to support Indonesia's energy transition.

Xurya's growth is driven by a strong culture of innovation, inclusion, and talent development. It hires from diverse backgrounds and offers structured training, mentorship, and career paths. Through its Solar Academy, it has trained over 200 Engineering, Procurement, Construction (EPC) professionals and developed clean energy leaders - reinforcing its role as a talent hub and its commitment to long-term national impact.

Today, Xurya is recognized for its impact and credibility. It is a certified B-Corporation (meets high standards of social and environmental performance, transparency and accountability), holds ISO certifications, and has been listed in the Forbes Asia 100 to Watch, G20 Top Green Startup, and Kehati ESG Awards. Its systems help avoid over 260,000 tonnes of CO emissions annually while helping clients improve energy efficiency. Eka continues to lead Xurya with a clear mission to accelerate the country's shift to clean, inclusive, and sustainable energy.

Jayadi Budiman

PT Jendela Kuliner Bersama



Jayadi Budiman began his entrepreneurial journey in 1997 by selling street food shortly after graduating from university. Over time, he expanded his efforts into building several successful lifestyle restaurants in Bogor. In 2018, he brought together a group of food-loving friends to co-found Kanma Group - “Kanma” being “makan” (to eat) spelled backward - a name symbolizing the spirit of gathering and shared culinary passion. The Group blends Indonesian culinary heritage with modern design and sustainability.

Kanma Group is known for reimagining traditional Indonesian dishes in contemporary spaces that appeal to younger generations. Restaurants like Kluwih Heritage, once recommended by President Jokowi as a family dining destination, and Kopi Nako, which modernizes the concept of a warteg and coffee stall, highlight this approach. Jayadi's ability to scale culturally rooted concepts while maintaining consistent quality has made Kanma a strong player in the country's Food & Beverage (F&B) sector.

Sustainability is a key pillar in Jayadi's work. He initiated the Daur Baur Movement, which includes establishing a micro factory to recycle plastic waste from his outlets into design materials used in their interiors. Kanma also repurposes bottle caps, cans, and used barrels to minimize waste and promote environmental awareness within its operations.

Jayadi continues to grow Kanma Group with a strong sense of mission: to elevate Indonesian culinary culture while creating positive social and environmental impact. His ability to scale a business with purpose, empower people around him, and innovate across products and design reflects a clear entrepreneurial spirit and lasting impact on the F&B industry in Indonesia.

Marshall Pribadi

PT Privy Identitas Digital



Marshall Pribadi is an entrepreneur who has dedicated his career to building secure and practical digital solutions. As the Founder and CEO of Privy, he established Indonesia's first licensed digital identity and signature platform, helping businesses and individuals verify identities, sign documents, and onboard users with confidence. Since starting Privy in 2016, he has grown the Company to serve more than 65 million users and over 145,000 enterprises, including many of Indonesia's largest banks, insurance companies, and government institutions.

From the start, Marshall prioritized reliability and compliance, making Privy the first non-government Certificate Authority in Indonesia. The Company earned key certifications like ISO 27001 and WebTrust, and in 2023, marked its regional expansion with an office in Sydney. These milestones reflect his focus on solving real-world problems with user- and regulation-driven technology.

In addition to his work at Privy, Marshall plays a key role in Indonesia's digital ecosystem. He serves as Chairman of the Indonesia Digital Trust Association, Vice Chairman of AFTECH, and Chairman of the Indonesia RegTech and LegalTech Association. He was also selected for Forbes Asia 30 Under 30 and is a member of Endeavor Global's network of high-impact entrepreneurs.

Marshall's leadership at Privy goes beyond technology. The Company runs internal hackathons, mentorship programs, and structured career acceleration tracks for employees. His personal experience with inefficient paper processes inspired him to create tools that make digital interactions safer and more efficient. Through Privy, he continues to support the development of a trusted digital environment for Indonesia and the broader region.

Shinta Nurfauzia

PT Lemonilo Indonesia Sehat



Shinta Nurfauzia is the Co-Founder of Lemonilo, a company focused on producing healthier and more affordable packaged food products for the Indonesian market. Starting with one instant noodle variant, Lemonilo has expanded its portfolio to include a range of additive-free snacks and meals made with real ingredients. Shinta and her co-founders built the business to address the gap in the local market for nutritious food options that are also accessible in price. She plays an active role in shaping the Company's mission, product development, and quality standards.

Shinta leads with consistency and clarity, setting high standards for product integrity and team discipline. She launched internal programs like Lemonilo Fit Club and Lemonilo Growth Partner to promote health and continuous learning. Her leadership fosters an inclusive culture, with over 40 percent of managerial roles held by women, and supports flexible work, child-friendly spaces, and working parents.

Lemonilo has grown its presence across Indonesia and expanded to international markets such as the United States and Middle East. Its products have entered retail chains and export channels, supported by participation in trade events like Gulfood and SIAL (Salon International de l'Alimentation - International Food Exhibition). Some of its products, including the Korean-style spicy noodles and Brownies Crispy, became category leaders.

Beyond Lemonilo, Shinta engages in public discussions on health and entrepreneurship. She supports outreach programs with schools, ministries, and NGOs to raise health awareness. Lemonilo has partnered with groups like Foodcycle and Yayasan Pulung Pinasti to distribute nutritious food and promote healthy living. The Company remains focused on product quality, employee growth, and social impact, aligned with its long-term mission.

PT Sarana Pactindo



Sutjahyo Budiman is the Co-Founder and CEO of PT Sarana Pactindo (Sarana Pactindo Group). He began his career in software quality assurance and product development before moving into sales leadership at Sigma Caraka Cipta. After Telkom acquired this company, he started Dwidasa Samsara Indonesia, his own software consulting firm. He later founded PT Fortress Data Services Indonesia (FDS) to deliver core banking systems and PT Sarana Pactindo (PAC) to focus on payment infrastructure, both under a managed services model tailored for Indonesia's banking sector.

Sutjahyo built FDS and PAC in response to growing demand for digital solutions in banking. Over the years, these companies have grown to serve financial institutions with a wide range of services, including regulatory reporting, fraud detection, payment systems, and IT operations. These offerings were designed to meet the standards of regulated banks while remaining adaptable for non-bank clients. His approach emphasized high service quality, strong domain expertise, and reliable long-term support for each client.

In 2025, he led the merger that formed Sarana Pactindo Group to streamline operations and support regional expansion. The Group now provides end-to-end digital solutions for banks and financial institutions, from software development to hybrid infrastructure, helping clients digitize efficiently, reduce vendor complexity, and improve cost control.

Sutjahyo also instills strong organizational values, enforcing zero tolerance for fraud, promoting win-win partnerships, and fostering inclusive decision-making across all levels. Through collaborations with financial institution networks in Indonesia and the Philippines, he expands digital access to underserved communities while enhancing Indonesian tech capabilities in the region.

Tomy Yunus Tjen and Yohan Limerta are the founders behind Cakap, one of the leading education technology platforms in Indonesia. Their shared experience as students in China, where they recognized the life-changing impact of language learning, became the inspiration for building a platform to improve access to quality education in Indonesia. Starting with a focus on digital language learning, they developed Cakap into a broad upskilling platform that now reaches learners across the country from major cities to rural areas.

Under their leadership, Cakap has grown from a small startup into a national platform serving over 6 million learners and employing more than 2,900 educators. The Company offers four main products: language courses, professional upskilling, corporate training, and children's education. Through its hybrid and online models, Cakap addresses Indonesia's skill gaps, improves job readiness, and helps bridge educational inequality, especially for underserved communities.

Tomy and Yohan have been recognized by the G20 Innovation Award, Forbes Asia 100 to Watch, and Fortune Indonesia's 40 Under 40. They have also represented Indonesia at the World Economic Forum and Global EdTech Startup Awards, reflecting their leadership and Cakap's growing role in Indonesia's digital learning ecosystem.

Beyond business growth, they are committed to inclusive and sustainable education. Through Cakap Untuk Bangsa, the Company has provided free courses to underserved communities since 2020, supported career-switching educators, especially women, and embedded Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) principles into its operations. This reflects their mission to make education a driver of social mobility and national progress.
