I previously wrote to creditors on 4 December 2025, providing notice of my intention to seek the consent of the High Court, under Paragraph 98(2) of Schedule (B1) of the Insolvency Act 1986, for Alan Hudson's, Sam Woodward's and my discharge from liability as Joint Administrators.

The application for our discharge was made prior to the Administration extension hearing with a request that both the extension and discharge applications were heard together to reduce costs to the Company's creditors associated with two court hearings and to avoid significant delays currently being experienced regarding Court hearings.

I stated that I would provide further notice to creditors once a Court hearing had been listed for the discharge application.

I can now confirm that the application for discharge will be heard together with the Administration extension hearing on 13 January 2026 at 2pm at 4th Floor Reception Desk, Courts 88-92, Thomas More Building, Royal Court of Justice Strand, London, WC2A 2LL.

An update on the outcome will be provided to the creditors after the hearing.
