I previously wrote to creditors on 15 October 2025, providing notice of my intention to seek the consent of the High Court, under paragraph 76(2) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, for an extension of the Administration for a further period of six months, ending on 4 August 2026 (the "Notice"). The Notice sets out the purpose of the extension.
