**Arrival Automotive UK Limited (formerly in Administration and now in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation) ('the Company')**

As you may be aware, the Administration of the above Company came to a close on 6 August 2025, at which date the Company was placed into Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation ("CVL").

I previously wrote to creditors on 20 August 2025, providing the notice of my intention to seek the consent of the High Court, under paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, for Alan Hudson's, Sam Woodward's and my discharge, as former Joint Administrators of the Company, from liability in respect of any action taken as Joint Administrators.

The application sought for the Court to grant the order retrospectively from the date the Administration came to an end, being 6 August 2025.

I confirm that a court hearing has been scheduled for 9 February 2026 at Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Insolvency and Companies List (ChD), The Rolls Building, 7 Rolls Buildings, Fetter Lane, London EC4A 1NL.

Please note that we do not currently have a time for the hearing.

An update on the outcome will be provided to the creditors after the hearing.
