**UPON** the Application of Samuel James Woodward of Ernst & Young LLP, 2 St Peters Square, Manchester, M2 3EY and Colin Peter Dempster of Ernst & Young LLP, Atria One, 144 Morrison Street, Edinburgh, EH 3 8EX, the Joint Administrators (“**Administrators**”) of National Holidays Tours Limited (In Administration) (company number 03213927) (“**Company**”).

**AND UPON** the court considering the Application dated 2 September 2022 (“**Application**”) and reading the witness statement of Samuel James Woodward dated 1 September 2022 and exhibit thereto and the Skeleton Argument of Mr Ian Tucker, Counsel for the Administrators.

**AND UPON HEARING** Mr Ian Tucker, Counsel for the Administrators.

**IT IS ORDERED** that:-

1. Pursuant to section 176A(5) of the Insolvency Act 1986, subsection (2) of section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986 (concerning the making of a prescribed part available to unsecured creditors of the Company) shall not apply and accordingly the Joint Administrators shall not reserve or distribute the prescribed part of the Company’s net property to its unsecured creditors.

2. Pursuant to rule 12.16(2) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016, the Joint Administrators shall as soon as reasonably practicable deliver notice to creditors by publishing a notice of the Order on the website previously notified to all known creditors of the Company in accordance with Rule 1.50 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016.
3. The costs of and incidental to the Application be paid as an expense of the administration of the Company.
