From 2000 to 2007, Michael was President of ParadigmHealth, now part of Optum Health, and from 1993 to 2000, he was President and Founder of Theraphysics, a venture-backed specialty rehabilitation firm. Michael's contribution to entrepreneurship is at the heart of everything he does.
